Letter 'r' - say: "start at the top come down, bounce back up and over."

Letter 'n' — say: "start at the top come down, bounce back up, go over, down and flick."

Letter 'm'— say: "start at the top come down, bounce back up and over. Down, bounce back up and over, down and flick."



We have been learning about height. We have compared the heights of different items, putting them in order from the shortest to the tallest. Your child's task this week is to order 5 toys from shortest to tallest. Once they have completed this, we would like them to see if they can: find an object that is double the size of their smallest toy find an object that is approximately half the height of their tallest toy.
